Gr 1-3--This simple porquoi story tells the tale of a devious two-legged spider who wants to win a race. He first petitions the wish-granting Great Hippo for two powerful legs like those of the ostrich. However, he finds that he simply cannot run on those legs, and so repeats his request until finally the hippo gives him eight cheetah legs. In return for granting his requests, Great Hippo requires only that Spider answer one question honestly when the time comes. When he cheats in order to win, Great Hippo's question comes in to play, and because Spider answers truthfully, he gets eight legs of his very own that work quite nicely, thank you.
