

Lesson Title: *Sounds*

Grade Level/ Subject Area: 2nd Grade / Science

Time Allotted: 10 – 15 minutes

In this lesson the students will categorize different sounds according to their pitch from loudest to softest.

The sounds will be on the Computer (to be downloaded to a CD), The students will in a whole group setting. The CD will be in the Listening Center in the classroom or on the computer.

GLE 0207.11.2 Classify sounds according to their loudness and pitch.

Instructional Objectives:

1. The Learners will listen to the CD and rate the sound as High, Medium, or Low Pitch.
2. The Learners will guess what each sound belongs to.

Materials, Resources, Technology:

1. CD/Tape Player or Computer
2. Copy of the Sound File on CD from the Computer
3. Worksheet for each child
4. Music Teacher – instruments

Student's Present Level of Performance and Knowledge:

The students listen to sounds in their environment everyday.

Instructional Process:

1. The instructor will start by talking about the sounds we hear in our environment everyday.
2. Hand out the worksheet to each child.
3. Have the learners to close his/her eyes and listen to the sounds on at a time.
4. Then have the learners to write their guess on what the sound is.
5. Have the learners to rate the pitch as High, Medium, or Low, by placing a check in the box.

Lesson Closure:

After all the sounds have been played, and the worksheet has been finished, go over the worksheet together.

Adaptations for Special Learners:

Peer pairing, clue cards, and Head phones of the *hearing challenged*
For the Visually Challenged Learner – Raise right hand for high, raise the left hand for Medium and raise both hands for low pitch.

Assessment/ Evaluation:

The students will turn in the recording sheet to the instructor for review.
Watch the Physically challenged learners for clues and following directions.
