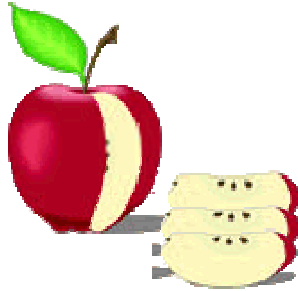

## Negotiations Successful!

- Teachers received a 4% pay increase in Jefferson County for 2006-2007. This is the first locally negotiated salary % based on the state amount.
- Teachers will also receive a state-funded bonus in October. The bonus will be approximately \$267 per employee. The new contract will go to the printer in late September.
