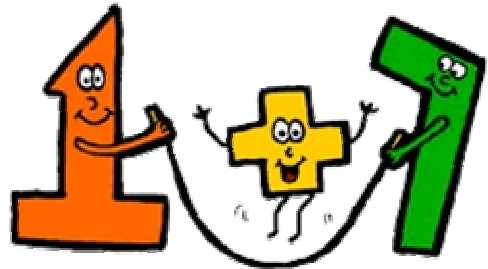
Instructions: Choose the answer that correctly combines the following underlined sentences.
